

Tiraspol (since 1792)

short historical facts:

Tiraspol is the capital of the Pridnestrovian Moldavian Republic (Transnistria).

Tiraspol was founded by the Russian generalissimo Alexander Suvorov in 1792 as a fortress, although the area had been inhabited for thousands of years by different ethnic groups. In the town's early history it switched hands from the Greeks, to Romans, Ottoman, Turks, and more.

The name "Tiraspol" is derived from the Greek, which named the city after the river on which it sits. This river, today known as the Dniestr River was called the Tyras River by the Greeks and their name for a city, Polis was combined to form Tiraspol.

The city celebrates its anniversary every year in autumn, on October 14. (This year it will be 225 y.o.)

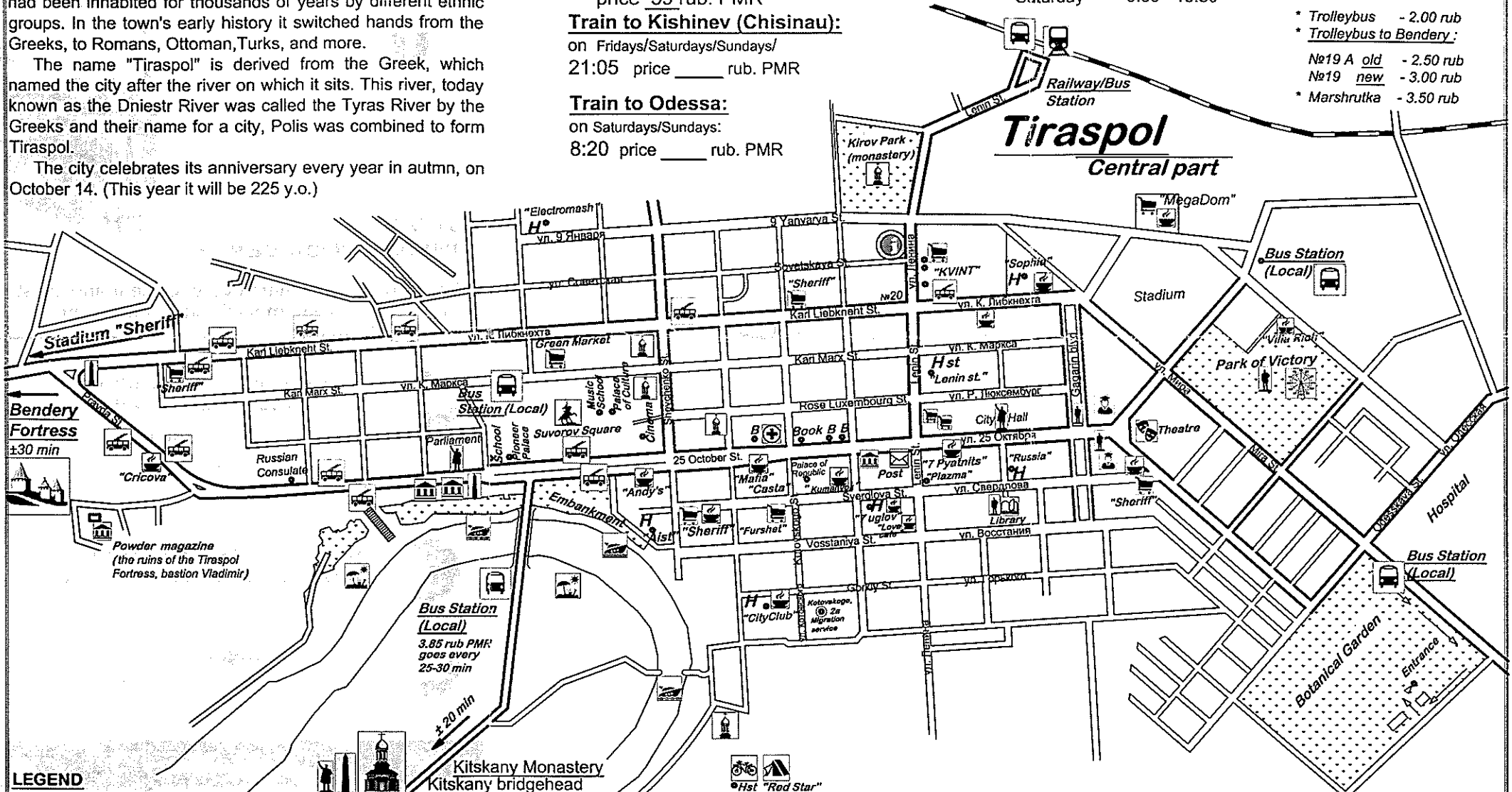
